The mission of JD Breast Cancer Foundation is to *provide essential services to young women with breast cancer by offering financial assistance, emotional support, and education to enhance survivorship.*

Although the incidence of breast cancer in young women is much lower than that of older women, young women's breast cancers are generally more aggressive, are diagnosed at a later stage, and result in lower survival rates. *In fact, breast cancer is the leading cause of cancer deaths in young women under the age of 40.*

In 2010, JDBCF provided funding to more than 100 women throughout northeast Ohio who were faced with the challenges of combating breast cancer while taking care of their families. The financial support given helped these women focus on treatment options by providing them with assistance with their mortgage and rent payments, utility bills, and keeping food on their tables. *Thank you Susan G. Komen for the Cure Northeast Ohio Affiliate for your generous support towards our financial aid services.*

JD Breast Cancer Foundation's Young Survivors Symposium, held during National Breast Cancer Awareness Month in October, *provided more than 100 breast cancer survivors and their families with tools and education needed to take on the effects of breast cancer and enhance their lives.*

The *2010 Golf-A-Thon successfully brought golfers together to raise more than \$25,000* for the Foundation.

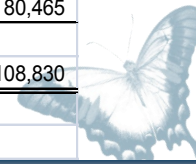

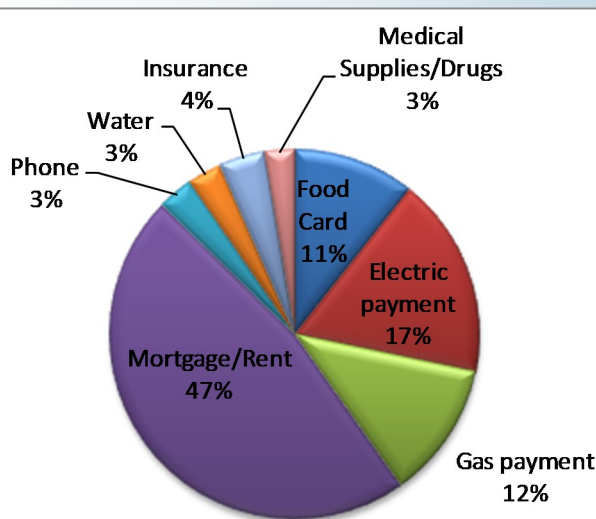

(April 2010– December 2010)**



In 2010, the Foundation was able to assist 84 individuals with a total of \$39,404.77. We provided over 180 direct services for an average of \$428.31 per application and an average \$469.10 per recipient.
